SCHOOL AFFILIATION

Christopher Education is managed by the School Advisory Board and is affiliated to the Board of Secondary Education, Manipur.

EXAMINATION

Class I – **VIII:** There will be two semester/term examinations that will include Half Yearly and Annual Examination.

1st Semester:

Class IX & X follows the Board Pattern. There will be two semester examinations. In each semester there will be two term tests and one Half yearly examinations (Half Yearly and Annual Examination)

CRITARIA FOR PROMOTION

The promotion of a child shall be determined by the Principal in consultation with subject and class teachers. Promotions will be made only at the end of an academic year. To promote from one class to another, a child must have spent one year in the previous class and have fulfilled the condition for class Promotion. Promotion for all classes will be decided on the average of the performance throughout the year.

Apart from the child's progress his/her conduct & attendance will also be considered when making the final decision on promotion. Attendance of at least 80% is required for a child to be eligible to promote for the next higher class.

MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION

The medium of instruction is **English**.

To develop maximum fluency in English, it is mandatory to use English at all times inside the school premises. The respective language should be used during the MIL classes.

RULES CONCERNING ABSENCE

- 1 Leave of absence is not granted except on prior application from the Parents/Guardians in case of unforeseen circumstances.
- 2 For leave of absence for more than 7 days. Parents must meet the Principal and get the leave granted.
- 3 Absence from school during tests/examination/ sports / functions will not be condoned except in case of illness and will adversely affect the student's grade in the test / examination. Neither retest nor re-examination will be conducted. No average will be given.
- 4 Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than two weeks (10 days)(a week i.e., 5days for classes IX & X) renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls, re-admission will have to be sought.
- 5 Any student having less than 80% attendance shall not be promoted to the next higher class.

STATEMENT MADE BY PARENT/GAURDIAN

I have read the rules and regulation of the school as given in the school diary / prospectus and I promise to abide by them and see that my child conforms to the standard excepted of him/her in conduct and studies and that I agree to submit myself to decisions of the management regarding punctual payment of Tuition Fees and other fees (which are levied from time to time).

Free Feeship

Students who secured the highest marks in an Academic session i.e., totaling of all the examinations are awarded admission free when he/she is promoted/admitted to the next higher class. The award covers from Nursery to Class IX.

For such a student awarded three consecutive years will be given Excellency Award in which all the fees (admission + 12 months tuition fee) will be exempted. The award covers from Nursery to Class IX.

P. Shanta Memorial Meritorious Award

This award is sponsored by **Dr. Robin S Pukhram**, Managing Director, Christopher Education, in the loving memory of late P. Shanta Singh and is awarded a cash of ₹2000/- with a citation to the Best First Divisioner who came out in the HSLC Examination.

Teachers' Incentive Award

With a view to enthuse the teachers in producing quality students teachers' Incentive Award is sponsored by **Dr. Robin S Pukhram**, Managing Director, Christopher Education, and is awarded a sum of ₹1000/- for the academic year to the teacher who produce student(s) securing letter marks in HSLC Examination.

IMPORTANT RULE OF THE SCHOOL

Kindly Attention: Parents/Guardians.

- 1 Parents are requested to look into the school diary of their child daily. Remarks made in the diary should be seen and countersigned regularly.
- 2 Children should be sent to the school in a neat and full school uniform.
- 3 Fees must be paid on or before the 10th of every month.
- 4 Fees once paid are neither refundable nor transferable.
- 5 All the payable school fees are to be paid for the whole academic year (Jan Dec).
- 6 If seeking transfer of ward from the school midway through the academic session, the payable fees for the rest of the academic session must be cleared.
- 7 A fee concession of 50% will be granted to the third child onwards of the same parent.
- 8 In case your child is sick do not send him/her to the school. Please do not ask for half day leave.
- 9 If your child is not assigned home-work on any day, please contact the principal.
- 10 Parents should carefully fill the personal memo in the school diary.
- 11 A fine of ₹.100/- will be charged if the student loses the original diary/ fee slip / report card.

- 12 Do not criticize the school / teacher in the presence of your child. If you have legitimate complaint, please meet the principal without any hesitation.
- 13 Parents are requested to encourage neither ward to keep their school bags properly and carry them on their own.
- 14 Please encourage your ward to show his/her diary to the class teacher when even any written test/message meant for the principal / class teacher is sent by you through the relevant pages of the school diary.
- 15 In case your ward is suffering from any medical problem like Allergy or other problem, kindly notify so that appropriate medical attention can be taken.
- 16 Every student should wear school uniform on all school days and in all functions, all children are expected to come to school diary in freshly laundered uniform with socks and well polished shoes. Any child who doesn't come in full school uniform will be excluded from the class/ sent home / suspended from the school.
- 17 Students must take care of school property. They should not write or scars on desks, chairs, wall or doors of the school nor should they damage property belonging to others. Any damage done must be remitted by the offender.
- 18 The school is not responsible for any loss of goods, money or jewellery. Money should not be lent or borrowed or articles exchanged.

- 19 A student who uses unfair means during the test/Exams will be given a Zero in the subject and a warning letter issued to him/her. Repetition of the same will result in dismissal. Any student who is found tampering with marks in the Report Card and other school certificates will be asked to leave the school.
- 20 Students and parents should not offer any present or gifts to the teachers except with explicit permission of the Principal.
- 21 Wearing of valuables/jewellery are strictly prohibited. Any complaint of loss of such articles will not be entertained though every attempt will be made to locate it.
- 22 A student who fails to attain the required standard in all the subjects will not be promoted. Reports of general progress will be given in the Progress Report. Promotions are granted on the basis of the whole year's performance. A student must acquire a minimum of 40% marks. Hence, the importance of regularity in attendance and work. Examinations are meant to confirm the result of the year's work. The decision of the school authorities with regard to promotion is final.
- 23 Parents/Guardians are not allowed to meet their children or the teachers during school hours without the prior permission of the principal.

- 24 In case of emergency/some urgency, please send a note through the gatekeeper and wait at the gate for a reply.
- 25 As the medium of instruction is English, all the students are compulsory to speak in English only in the school campus.
- 26 Parents/Guardians should not visit the class rooms during class hours, except with the permission of the principal. For any information regarding the school, contact the school office during the visiting hours.
- 27 Though the school takes all the normal precautions. It does not take any responsibility for accidents.

INTOXICANTS

Intoxicants like khaini, betelnut (paan), talab etc is strictly prohibited inside the school campus. Any substance abuse may result in suspension with a fine of ₹ 500/- or more and action will be taken depending on the seriousness of the substance abuse. If a student is repeating the same after given warning against him/her, he/she is liable to terminate from the school.

REFRESHMENT

Students of Kindergarten are provided drinking water and Tiffin. They may also bring biscuits or dry cakes for themselves. Students are not allowed to bring eatables other than these.

PAYMENT OF FEES

- 1. The fees of the school covers 12 calendar months. No reduction is made for holidays or broken period of illness. Pupils are to be charged full fees as long as their names are officially on the rolls.
- 2. Fees are to be paid within 10 days after the expiry of every month. Parents/guardian are therefore, advised to be prompt in the payment of fees.
- 3. Fees for the holiday months of June and December must paid in advance.
- 4. Fees once paid is neither refundable nor transferable.
- 5. The school fees and other fees are liable to be revised at any time as the need arises.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

Wearing of School Uniform is compulsory on all working days.
